Writing

✎ Writing is a difficult task for children as it combines several skills that they are still learning how to use. It always helps to encourage your child to write in fun ways:

- ✎ Make up funny sentences with your child and have them write them each day (i.e. The pig has pink shoes.).
- ✎ Write words to act out, put them in a bowl, and act them out with one another.
- ✎ Make silly captions for photos (real or from a magazine).
