Tips

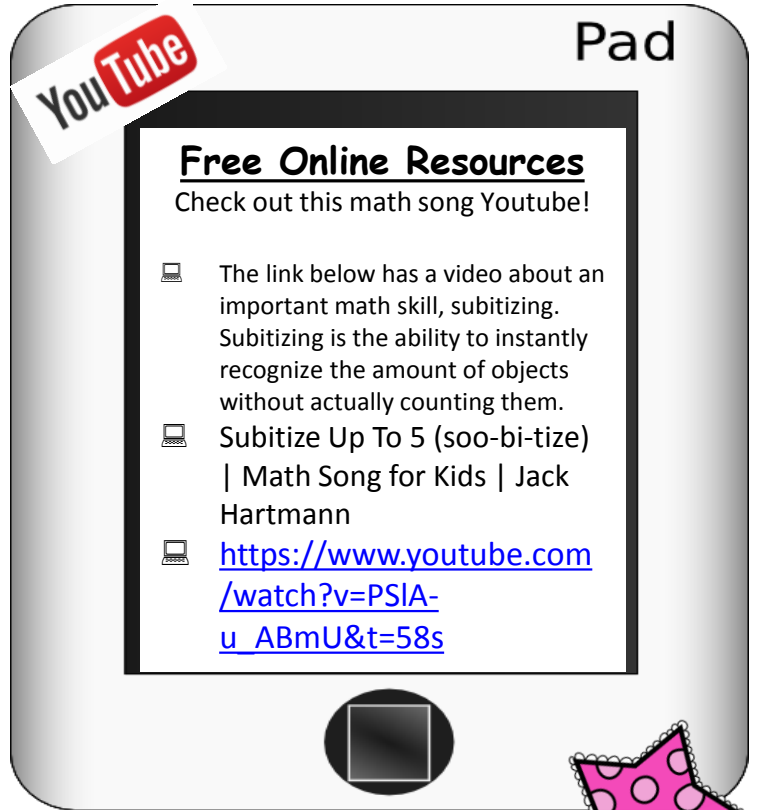
Recognizing Letters

- ✎ Ask your child to look for a certain letter on a TV show/commercial, in the grocery store, sign/billboard, etc.
- ✎ Ask your child to circle or highlight certain letters on their cereal box, newspaper, magazine, etc. You could also have your child cut and glue the same letter on a paper to create an alphabet book.
- ✎ Play a game by hiding letters around the room. Your child can earn a point if they can find and name the letter. If not, you can re-hide the letter to give them another chance.

Thinking Outside The Box

Reading is an important skill we use everyday. Encourage your child by sharing how knowing how to read helps you.

- 📖 Read a recipe card and making something yummy together.
- 📖 Read the instructions to a game before playing together.

Activity To Try

Make a Scrapbook!

- ✎ Make a scrapbook of a family event such as a holiday get-together, vacation, sports event, or special outing.
- ✎ Have your child create captions for the photos. These could be a sentence about the event or speech bubbles with dialogue saying what the person in the photo might have said at the moment the photo was taken. (Have your child trace over your handwriting.)
